We shall hide eggs around the garden for the children to find. Once they have found their eggs they will be able to exchange them for a chocolate one on their way home.

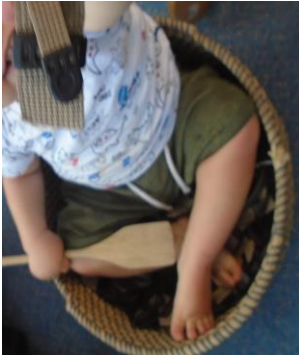
There will be hot cross buns and refreshments on offer so please save the date in your diary and we look forward to seeing you all there.

Pear Tree Class

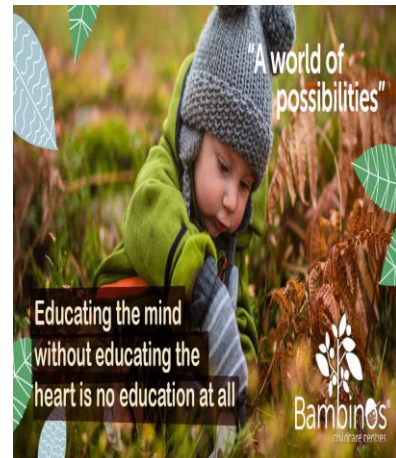

The children have had lots of fun exploring different messy play activities such as Jelly play, marble painting and making our own playdough.

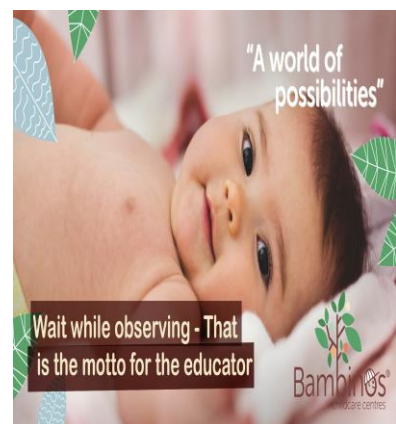
The children have also enjoyed playing outside in the garden and exploring the textures outside.
