Mother's Day Tea Party.

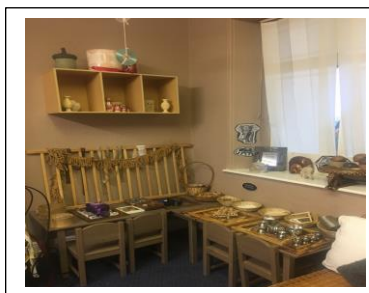
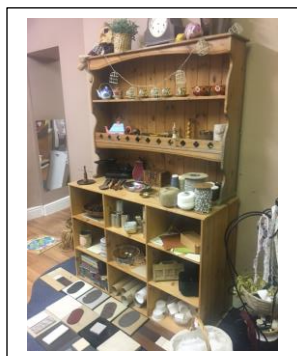
We would love to invite you to our Mother's day tea party at 4pm on Friday 29th March 2019. We will be doing some lovely activities for everyone to join in with.

Baby Unit

This month we will be starting to explore spring, we will do this by exploring different flowers. We will also be talking about baby animals and new colours we can see in our garden.
