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## Pear Tree Class

The children have had lots of fun exploring their senses, through bubble and feather/dance scarf play as well as using the puppets and the animals from their small world play to begin learning the sounds that different animals make, this links to communication and language.

We have also been learning about colours when we have been mark making with the crayons, chalks and paints creating masterpieces to take home, along with something for Mummy's special day, this links to Expressive arts and design.

We look forward to welcoming India to the class this month.

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## Willow Tree Class

The children have been really focusing on learning their colours, during circle time the children have been using flash cards with coloured shapes on to further develop their knowledge of shapes, from this the children have been sorting objects of the same colour which they have then matched to the colour cards, this links to mathematics.

We are spending lots of time in our garden and noticing the change of colours in our hedgerow, new buds and bird songs now that spring is upon us.

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## Oak Tree Class

The children have been exploring whilst in the garden looking for insects and bugs with the magnifying glasses along with pots to hold them in so that they can take a closer look at them before they release them back to nature.

The children have enjoyed exploring materials whilst making potions using water, spices and lentils. They have also been exploring using gloop where the children used cornflour and water to make a paste, this links to Expressive arts and design.
