Miss Polly Had A Dolly

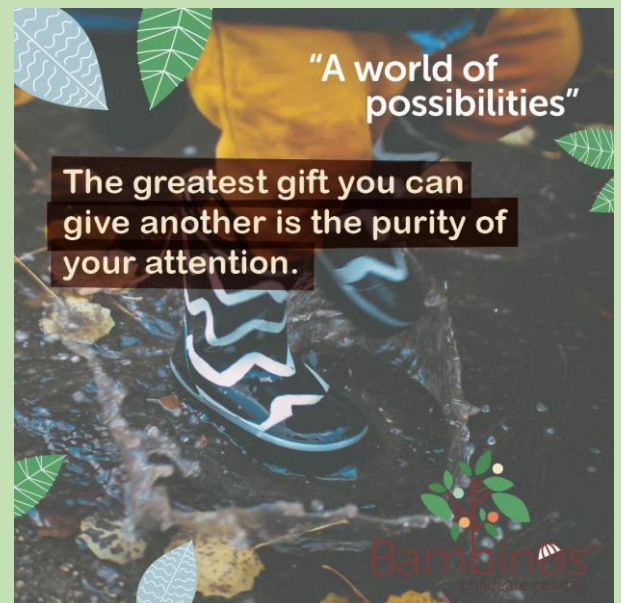
