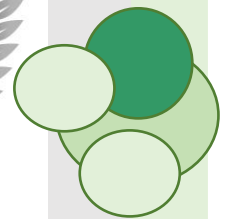

### Exit surveys...

We continually reflect on our practice and make improvements where they are needed. When children leave us to go to Primary school, we ask parents & carers to complete an exit survey. We are particularly interested to know your thoughts about how we have communicated with parents during Co-vid times. Our Risk Assessment has prevented families from coming into the building and our staff have missed the face-to-face conversations with you all - we have some ideas of how we can do things differently in September (should restrictions ease) and would really appreciate your feedback and suggestions.



## Transition

We have a transition process which aims to make the children's start to Nursery as smooth and as personal as possible. Generally, the process suits most children; however, some children will need more time and we will work together with you to manage this.

This transition period is very important as starting Nursery is a huge step for all children, even if they're used to being left or have attended another nursery. It is unlikely that they will have attended anywhere as big, or exciting or demanding as Nursery before, and it is only natural that they may feel a little overwhelmed at first.

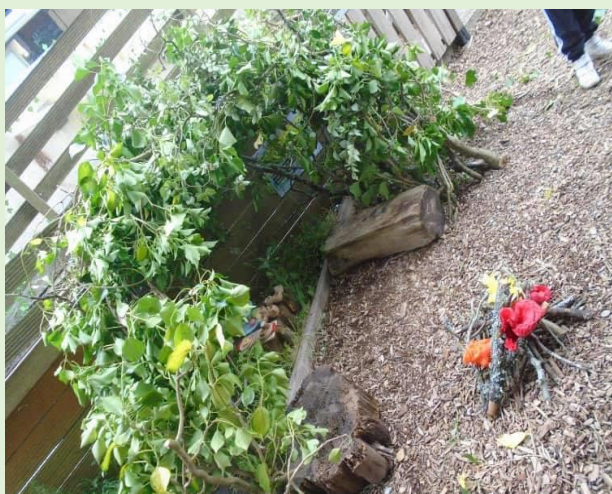
We do our utmost to make this transition as easy as possible for both children and their Parents/Carers – taking the initial steps gradually and carefully seems to work best.

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Top Tip for August:

Take 10!
